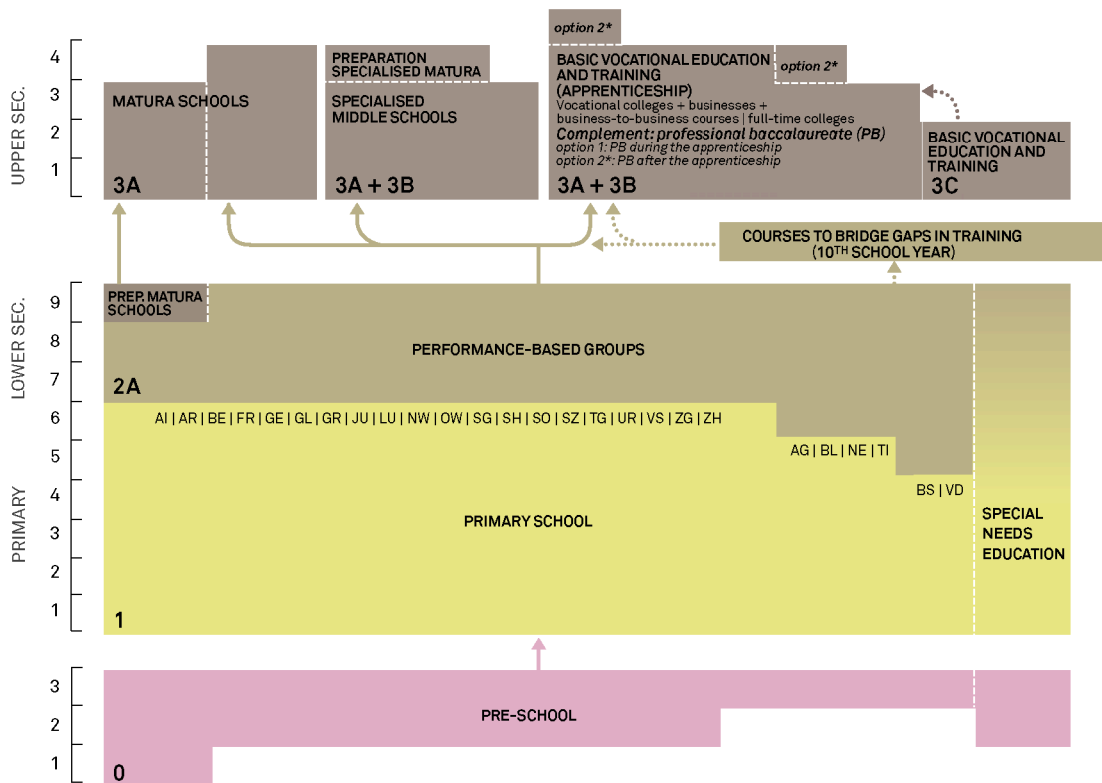
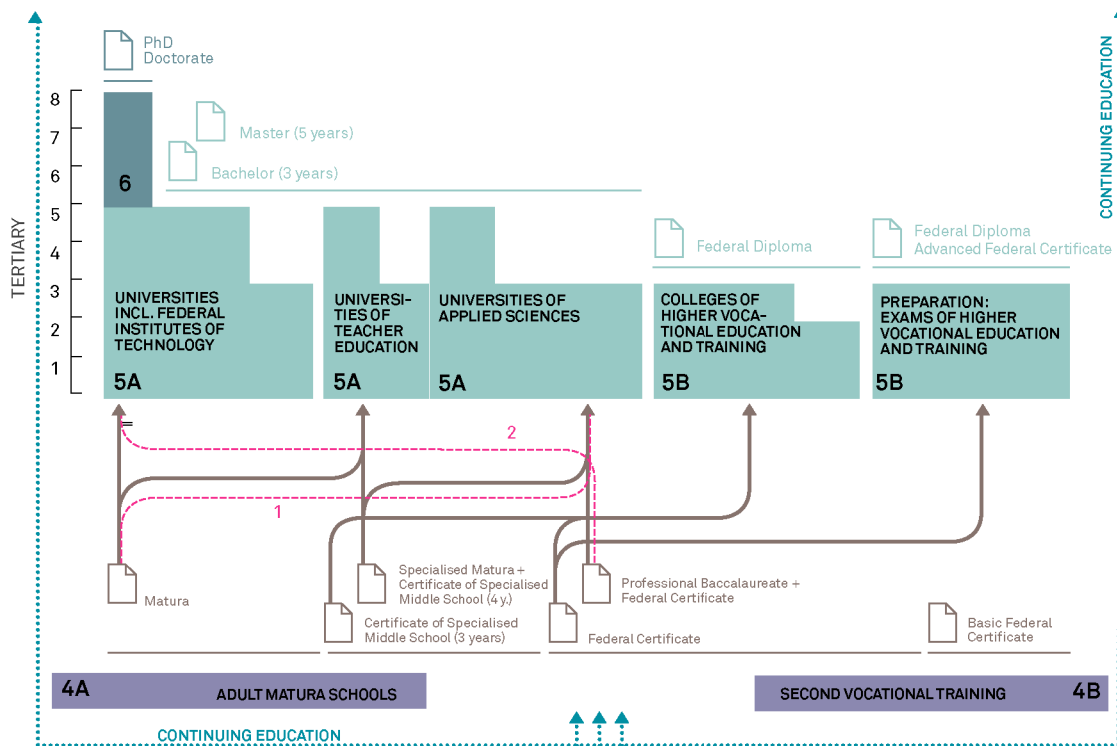


THE SWISS EDUCATION SYSTEM
